Hello All, Here is a letter from Kris Blank, Operations Coordinator of Missoula County Public Works. Purpose of letter is obtain the signatures of everyone wishing to participate in the 2023 season of Dust Abatement. The costs are to be determined later this month. Most likely .52 cents per lineal foot.(Pieces may come in higher however.) None of us are obligated in any way by signing this commitment letter as we can back out of agreement if we can't raise the funds. Our annual July cabin owner meeting occurs too late for planning and ordering magnesium chloride so this is an effort to let Missoula County know we are interested in a cost/share program of dust abatement. If we cannot secure the necessary funding we simply let the County know.

I am just taking a wild guess at how much of the road we would want treated. Thinking from fork in Lindbergh Lake road at campground junction to bridge over outlet of Lindbergh Lake. Guessing this is approximately one mile so am using 5,280 feet at .52 per foot. This is \$2,745.00. So we would need 27 individuals at \$100.00 each or perhaps some bulk funding from Lindbergh Lake owners as well. You never know they may be willing to contribute as they are part of the traffic.

I have no ideas how we communicate this information to Cygnet Lake owners. if we cannot do this then we should forget dust abatement for the 2023 season. Cathy and I will start the ball rolling by committing \$100.00 to this venture. We will need to let the county know via commitment letter by March 19, 2023. Let's see what we can do. Open to any and all ideas and suggestions and help. Thanks 406-241-1917
